Exhibition Overview

From 4-6 September 2024, after six years, inter airport returned to Beijing, its long-awaited destination, with its original intention unchanged and even more brilliance. A total of **95** premium brands from **13** countries and regions participated in the exhibition.

With the theme of "**Innovative Development, Connecting the World**," this exhibition focuses on core topics such as smart operations, safety assurance, green sustainability, and the human-centered airport concept. It brings together global renowned suppliers of airport facilities and equipment, technical experts, international construction companies, and planning consultancy agencies to jointly discuss and share the latest achievements and trends in the airport industry, contributing to the vigorous development of China's civil aviation sector.

This year's exhibition attracted **4,416** professional visitors from **30** countries and regions. At the same time, the 4th inter airport Exchange was held, featuring speeches from **56** prominent experts and senior executives from both domestic and international companies.

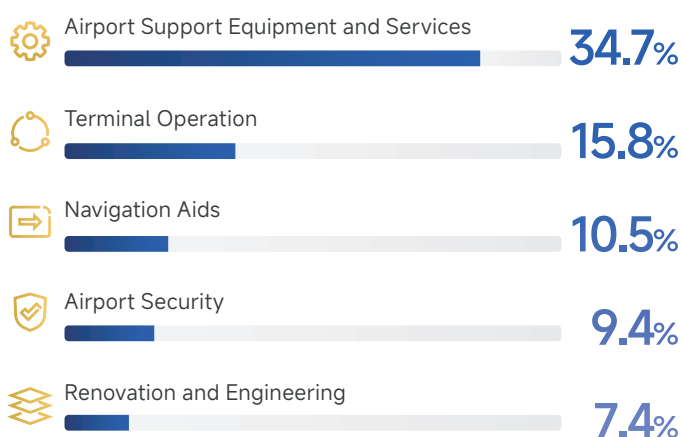

The security check simulation experience zone realistically recreates the airport security check process, including baggage inspection, hand luggage X-ray machines, and fixed-channel rapid security screening equipment. All intelligent security inspection equipment is presented in real-world scenarios, allowing participants to experience realistic operations. The fast, contactless security screening system serves as a highlight of the display, integrating functions such as identity verification, explosive detection, prohibited item detection, temperature monitoring, traffic control, hand luggage scanning, and full-body scanning into one system. This satisfies security requirements for the first line of defense at the entrance.

Satisfaction with Key Visitor Objectives

The forum concentrates on three key areas: intelligent operation, environmentally sustainable development, and integrated services. It aims to discuss how to promote comprehensive upgrades in the airport industry through cutting-edge technology and innovative strategies, further advancing the civil aviation sector and contributing to regional economic development.



Future Civil Aviation Digital Development Forum



In collaboration with the Civil Aviation Management Institute of China, the "Future Civil Aviation Digital Development Forum" was launched.
